-Ms. Conaway submitted lights for repair on Lehigh Drive and First Energy left a message for Ms. Conaway stating they are having a difficult time finding these lights.


EDGAR WENTZ


-Mr. Wentz reported that parking lot improvements at the Community Center continue to move forward.
