

TOWN OF UNION BRIDGE  
WORK SESSION  
April 12, 2021

The Council held a work session meeting on April 12, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., via GoToMeeting teleconference. Notice of the teleconferenced meeting was given by posting the agenda at the Town Hall, on the Town's website, and provision to the Carroll County Times. Those present were Mayor, Perry L. Jones Jr.; Donald Wilson; Ellen Cutsail; Laura Conaway; Amy Kalin; Edgar Wentz; and Clerk Treasurer, Dawn Metcalf.

MISCELLANEOUS DISCUSSION

-Today was the last day to fill out a Certificate of Nomination for the upcoming election. Election candidates are Laura Conaway, Ellen Cutsail, Amy Kalin, Charlene Johns and Cheri Thompson. The election for three (3) council members will be held on Tuesday, May 11, 2021.

-Circuit Rider, Mike Reynolds, was informed by Jeff Degitz that the County declined Union Bridge's proposal to transfer the remaining Community Center Parking Lot POS Funds to repair the Community Center roof. Mr. Degitz stated that the roof project is outside the project scope, that was previously submitted.

DONALD WILSON

-Mr. Wilson reported that work on the railroad crossing won't begin until late summer.

ELLEN CUTSAIL

-Ms. Cutsail thanked Council Member Laura Conaway for her "If I Were Mayor" essay contest, presentation to the fourth graders at Elmer Wolfe Elementary. Ms. Cutsail stated that over 1,200 essays were submitted.

-Ms. Cutsail is working on initiating the Disorderly House Ordinance.

AMY KALIN

-Amy Kalin reported that she received two (2) phone calls for water/sewer issues.

LAURA CONAWAY

-Ms. Conaway discussed the street lights on Lehigh Drive. Mr. Wilson will follow-up with Lehigh and see if they are interested in re-instating power connection.

EDGAR WENTZ

-Mr. Wentz stated that he and Mike Reynolds will work on getting estimates on the Community Center roof repair.


MAYOR JONES


-Mayor Jones recommended that a strip of bird repellent spikes should be included in the scope of work on the Community Center roof to deter the buzzards from roosting.
